Course Rules:

- i. Soft spikes are required; collared shirt required, and proper golf attire.
- ii. No outside food/beverage will be permitted on the course. Players are not permitted to bring alcohol onto the facility due to liquor license regulations.
- iii. Default tees: Monterey Pines will be Silver for Men and Green Tees for Women. Laguna Seca will be White for Men and Red for Women.
- iv. Players can choose to play tees other than the default tees.
- v. Team competition will be the low 8 of 10 net scores for each day.
- vi. Individual Flight competition in addition to Team competition.

USGA Rules of Golf Govern All Play on the Course INFORMATION

Unless noted below, all perimeter chain link fences bordering the course are out of bounds and Not an Obstruction that you can take relief from without penalty.

Holes # 1: Out of Bounds on right side of hole up till the cart path crosswalk that crosses the road towards Hole #2 tee box. OB stakes will be visible across the road near the crosswalk.

Holes # 2: No Out of Bounds on left side of hole. (There is OB on right side of hole #2.)

Holes # 3, 4 & 9: Chain link fence/Netting on the right side is treated as an obstruction. Take relief under Rule 16.1. Out of bounds on the other side of the fence.

Hole # 10: Out of Bounds on Right for play on #10 only. Building housing pump is an Immovable Obstruction. (NO "line of sight" relief.)

Holes # 16: Out of bounds as marked on left for any ball played on hole #16.

Holes # 17: OB Markers on the left side are for play on hole #16 only.

Hole # 18: Out of Bounds markers for hole #10 do not apply to play on hole #18.

FAA Poles and Protective Fences surrounding them are Immovable Obstructions. (NO "line of sight" relief.) Take relief under Rule 16.1.


Local Rule: A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes. (USGA Local Rule A-3)

Optional Local Rule for Ball Lost or Out of Bounds: USGA Local Rule E-5 is in effect only for regular non-tournament play on the course. For tournament players, please check with your tournament chairperson to see if this Local Rule is in effect for your event. There is a two-stroke penalty for taking relief for a Ball Lost or Out of Bounds under this Rule. For specifics on this Local Rule please ask one of our PGA Professionals for procedures on how to proceed when taking relief under this Rule.

THE USGA RULES OF GOLF GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHERE MODIFIED BY THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES:

- Out of bounds stakes between holes #4 and #5 apply when playing hole #5 only.
- Out of bounds stakes between holes #13 and #15 apply when playing hole #15 only.
- When playing holes #4 and #13, out of bounds stakes are declared immovable obstructions. Free relief may be taken under Rule 16.1b.
- During play of a hole, if a ball struck toward a golf cart path enters onto the path and rolls back toward the spot from where the ball was last played, free relief may be taken at the spot where the ball first entered onto the path.
- Golfers are responsible for any damage they incur to golf course property or neighboring property
- Yardage rocks are declared immovable obstructions. Free relief may be taken under Rule 16.1b.
- Yardage markers are measured to the center of the green.
